Colouring challenge





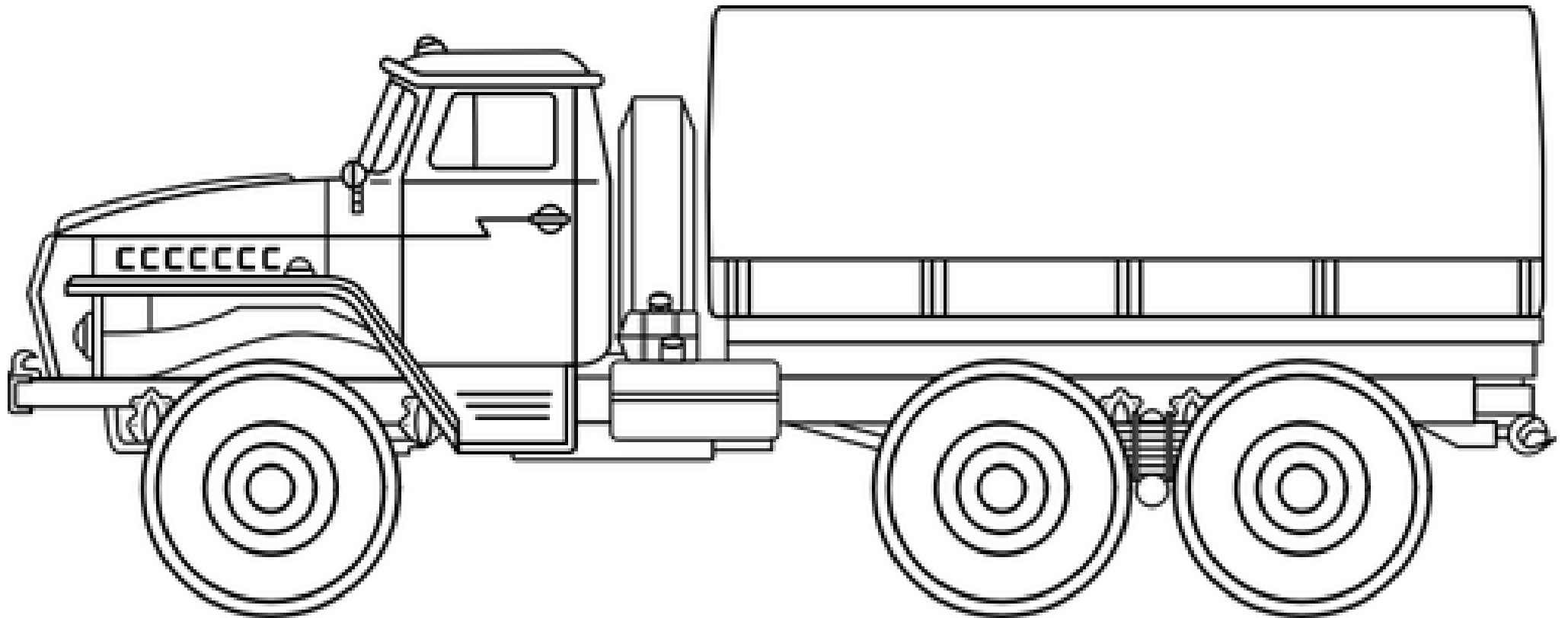
In a combat zone, you might not want the enemy to see you! By using different colours, patterns and materials, you can disguise your vehicle and even yourself.

To successfully deceive your enemy, you need to design your camouflage to match the type of terrain you are fighting in. For example, in the Arctic you'll want to use white to blend in with the snow.

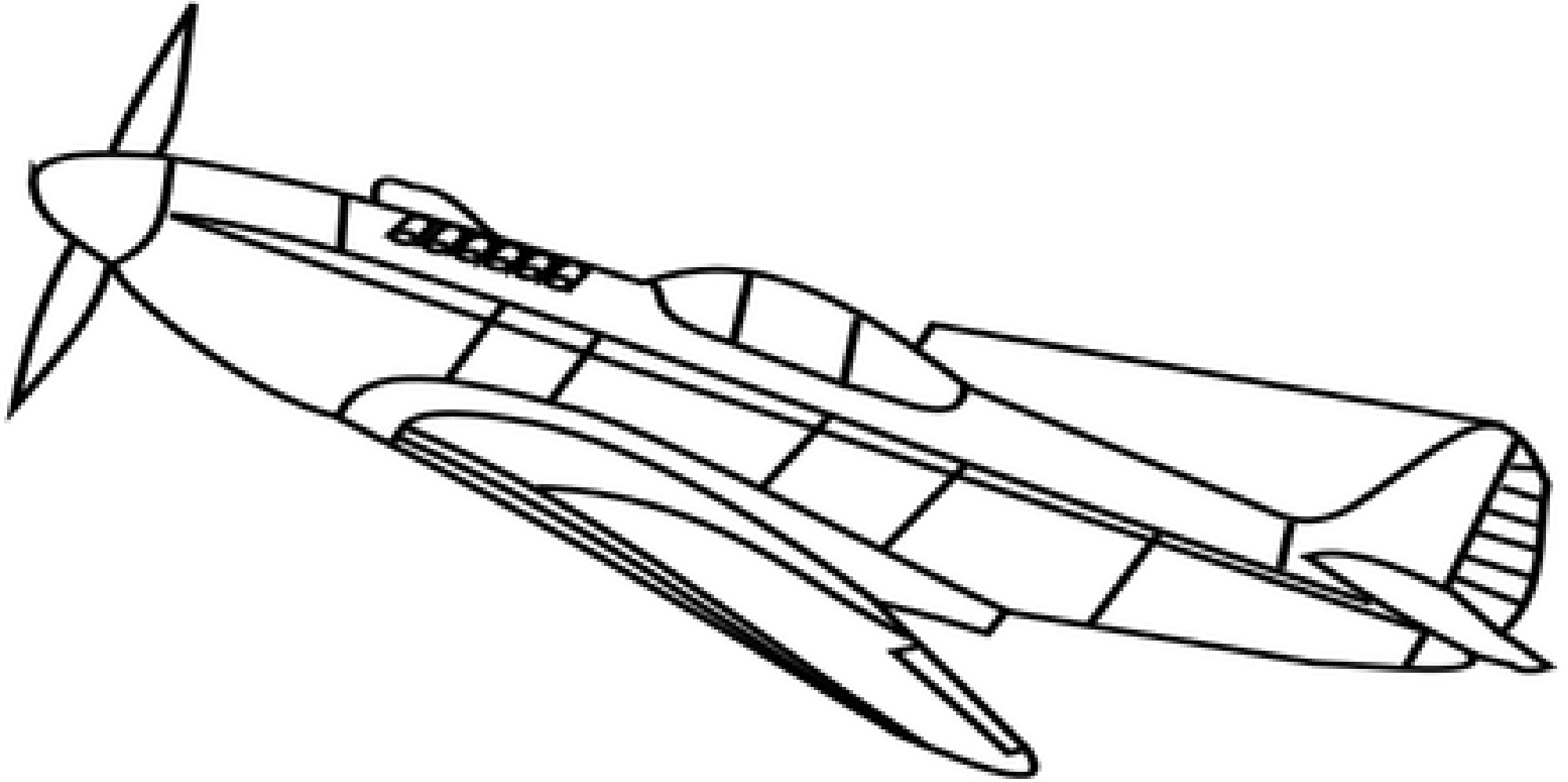
Take a look at these pictures for inspiration and then have a go at designing your own camouflage patterns on the colouring pages.

This truck is heading out on operation somewhere tropical. Design some camouflage for it so that it can hide whilst driving through the jungle.

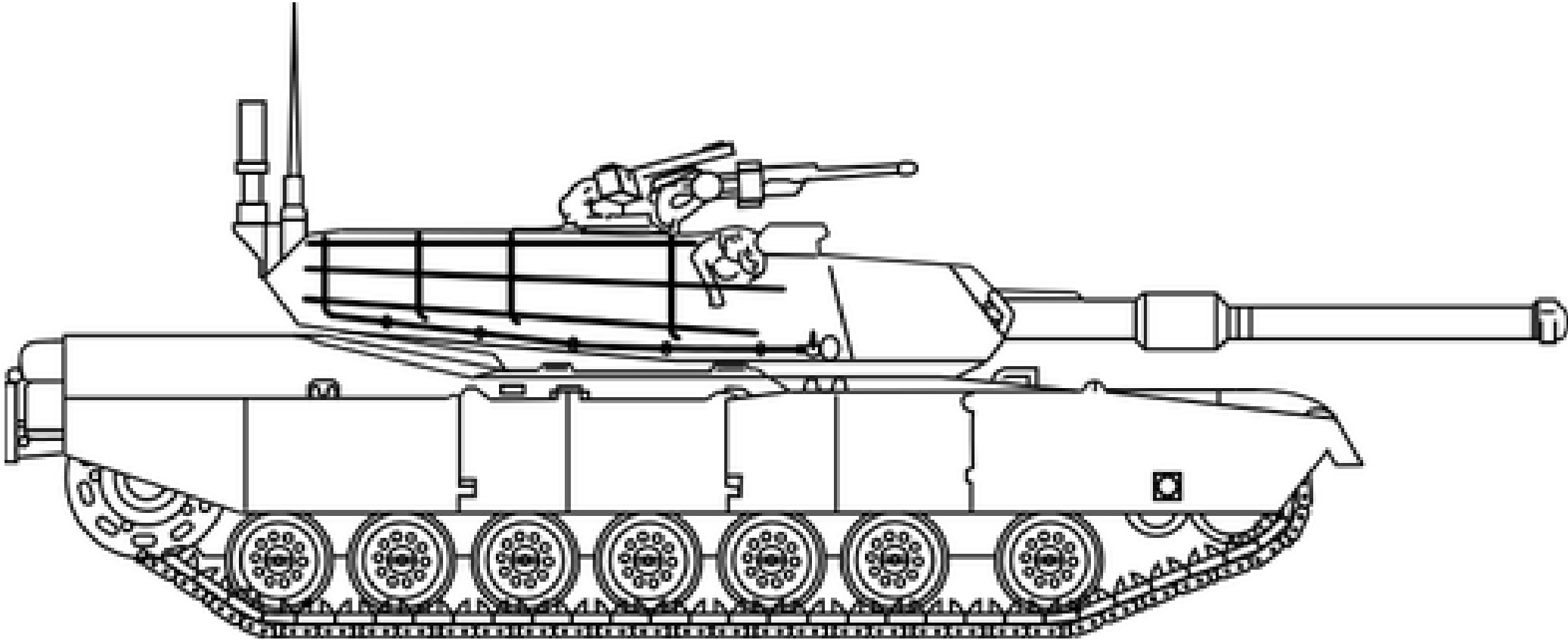
Top tip: Get inspired by nature! Try adding in some of the things you would commonly find in the jungle.
