

Arriving at Chicksands

The Military Intelligence Museum is located on a military base at Chicksands, Shefford, Bedfordshire.

By public transport:

Take the 9A or 9B bus (Hitchin-Bedford). Get off at the Chicksands Turn bus stop. You will then have a short walk down to the entrance of the camp. Use the following instructions to navigate your way there.


[Bedford station](#) and [Hitchin station](#) are the closest railway links with taxi ranks. It is then approximately a 20 minute drive to the museum.

By car:

You can access the camp gate from a turn off on the A600. There is no entry via Ampthill Road.

If you are driving, you can use the post code SG17 5QB for the Rowney Warren forest in your Sat Nav to get you to the correct side. Use the following instructions to arrive at the camp's entrance.





If you are approaching from Shefford turn left onto Sandy Lane. This is what the turn off looks like.



If you are approaching from Bedford, turn right onto Sandy Lane. This is what the turn off looks like.



Follow the road ahead through the forest, past the Rowney Warren forest car park.



Keep driving past the houses and factory buildings. At the end of the road you will see the entrance to the camp. Keep left.



Pull over and park in the lay-by.

Everyone in your party will then need to enter the Guardroom which is the building on the left. You may have to queue.

Tell the staff in the Guardroom that you are here to visit the museum. The staff will need to see your ID and will take a photograph of you. If you drove, they will ask you for your licence plate number.

A member of the museum team will then come to meet you and will escort you to the museum.
